2011 National Kidsafe Day Awards ...

Background

Kidsafe is the leading non-government, not-for-profit, charitable organisation dedicated to the prevention of unintentional injuries and associated deaths to children less than 15 years of age.

Kidsafe was established in 1979 as the Child Accident Prevention Foundation of Australia, with State Divisions being established in subsequent years. The name Kidsafe was adopted nationally in 1993.

In 2009, Kidsafe (The Child Accident Prevention Foundation of Australia) celebrated its 30th anniversary. This milestone provided a fantastic opportunity to re-establish national Kidsafe Awards. These recognised individuals who had made a significant contribution to child injury prevention or safety promotion during the past 30 years.

The Awards

The National Kidsafe Day Awards celebrate the achievements of children and adults in Australia in the field of child injury prevention and safety promotion. The 2011 National Kidsafe Day Awards, proudly supported by The Leycester Meares Bequest, will be announced on National Kidsafe Day, Tuesday 25 October 2011. The focus for the 2011 Awards will be on Road Safety Awareness, Advocacy and Action.

The Award categories (one winner from each category per state/territory) are:



Business Award

Recognises retailers / businesses who actively promote Road Safety for children through action, increasing awareness or advocacy.



Local Champion Award (Adult Award - Individual/Group)

Recognises individuals / groups who have actively contributed to improved road safety for children in their local community.



Kids teaching Kids Award (Child Award - Individual/Group)

Recognises school students, local clubs or individual children who are less than 18 years of age and who have actively contributed to road safety for children.

Nominations will be collected by Kidsafe WA and distributed to the nominee's local Kidsafe State/Territory office for judging and Award Presentation. Awards ceremonies will take place on National Kidsafe Day 2011 (Tuesday 25th October) in your state/territory.

Our Awards Supporter

The Honourable Mr Justice Meares, AC, CMG (1909-1994) led a distinguished career as a barrister, soldier and Judge of the NSW Supreme Court. On his retirement in 1979 he pursued his interest in working with national organisations whose aim was to assist those with a disability and to advocate for injury prevention particularly amongst children. Justice Meares played an integral role in establishing the Child Accident Prevention Foundation (CAPFA), otherwise known as *Kidsafe*. In 1995, CAPFA established a perpetual trust known as The Leycester Meares Bequest as a result of the significant financial contribution and valuable support received from Justice Leycester Meares over many years. *Kidsafe* would like to thank the Trustees of The Leycester Meares Bequest for their on-going commitment to providing funds to Kidsafe for projects with a national focus.

1. Definitions

Nominator – The person who has submitted a nomination to the Awards, nominating an individual, group, or business.

Nominee – The individual, group, or business that has been nominated for an Award by a Nominator.

2. Award Nominations

2.1 Nominations for the National Kidsafe Day Awards 2011 are free.

2.2 Nominations close 5pm AEST on Friday 16th September 2011. Kidsafe reserves the right to change the closing date at its discretion.

2.3 All valid nominations submitted will be considered by the judging panel. Nominations are deemed to be received at the time of receipt by Kidsafe either by electronic means (website or email) or physically (hand-delivered or Australia Post), and NOT at the time of transmission/delivery by the nominator.

2.4 No responsibility is accepted for nominations not received in their entirety by Kidsafe or incorrectly completed by the closing date and time. The judging panel's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into either during or after the awards program.

2.5 All nominations and additional information, including but not limited to photographs, pictures, published materials, pamphlets, computer disks, C.D.'s, videos or tapes, will remain the property of Kidsafe and not be returned.

2.6 Information provided will be used by Kidsafe for the marketing and publicity purposes of the National Kidsafe Day Awards.

2.7 If for any reason the Awards cannot be conducted as planned, due to causes beyond the control of Kidsafe, Kidsafe may cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Awards. Kidsafe will make all reasonable efforts to advise nominators of such circumstance.

3. Award Nominators

3.1 Any person over 12 years of age can nominate a current Australian resident or Australian business for an award. Where the nominator is between 12 and 17 years of age, Kidsafe will verify valid consent has been obtained.

3.2 Nominators can submit multiple entries in any of the award categories.

3.3 Prior to submitting a nomination for the Awards, nominators must obtain all the necessary permission for any information and photographs/images supplied to be used by Kidsafe for promotional purposes, including advertising, and agrees to participate in any promotional activities for Kidsafe, without payment, for the purposes of promoting the National Kidsafe Day Awards.

4. Award Judging

4.1 The Award nominations will be judged by the National Kidsafe Day Committee in consultation with the Kidsafe National Council State/Territory representatives.

4.2 The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

4.3 Category winners will be notified by phone and email and will be published on the Kidsafe website www.kidsafe.com.au and in the local State/Territory newspaper. The winners will be invited to attend an Award ceremony on National Kidsafe Day in their nominated State/Territory, Tuesday 25th October 2011.

5. Awards

5.1 Awards will be presented to the recipient or their representative, at an Awards ceremony on National Kidsafe Day, Tuesday 25th October 2011. No travel or accommodation subsidies are available for Award recipients to attend an Award Ceremony in their State/Territory.

5.2 Awards are not transferable or redeemable for cash.

5.3 Kidsafe will not be liable for any loss, damage or any personal injury sustained as a result of taking or using the Awards.

Entry into the Awards constitutes the entrant's acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

 - * *What has been done?*
 - * *How was it done?*
 - * *What effect or impact did it have?*
- *Evidence of action to promote road safety should also be provided (eg photos, posters etc)*

Who can nominate:

- *Any Australian Resident*
- *Customers of the Business*
- *Business owners*
